ROSSDALE BIG BIN EVENT - SEP 19-20 & ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING Sept 20.

- Bins will be set up in the parking lot of Rossdale Community Hall, 10135 96 Avenue.
- First-come/first served.
- Volunteers will be positioned to direct residents to the disposal bins but they will not assist with loading or unloading. Please ensure you can offload your items.
- We will commence taking loads for disposal at 9:00 am, Sat. Sep 19.
- Last load(s) will be ~2:45 pm, Sun. Sep 20.
- Residents will be required to provide proof of residency.
- Social distancing and the wearing of PPE (mask and/or gloves) is mandatory.
- One load/residence, per day, is allowed & subject to space availability.
- The Executive reserves the right to limit or refuse items for disposal

The following items <u>WILL NOT be accepted</u> for disposal:

- Hazardous waste or materials.
- Liquid waste of any type, or any container that may have held any type of liquid waste (e.g. solvents, pesticides, herbicides, etc.).
- Paint cans, paint pails, or any other form of paint containers that may have held paint.
- Oil or petroleum products of any kind including cans, containers, hoses, etc. that have held a petroleum product.
- Batteries; however, automotive batteries are allowed (see enviro fee schedule)
- Pressurized containers such as aerosol cans, propane bottles, etc.
- Railroad ties or any other pressured-treated wood.
- Manure animal waste of any kind.
- Dead animals or carcasses.
- Contaminated topsoil, clay, or any other type of soil.
- Concrete pieces, any size larger than small bricks.
- Drywall -- drywall mud/glue containers will be allowed but must be opened and dried out.

The following items will be accepted, with limitations, and recycling fees* apply:

- One mattress, fridge, freezer or other major appliance will be allowed per Rossdale resident (see enviro fee schedule). Again, please ensure that you can unload and place your discarded appliance in the bin; no assistance will be provided.
- Tires on or off the rim are allowed (see enviro fee schedule)
- Fees are due and payable prior to disposal cash or personal cheques only, please. Cheques to be made payable to The Rossdale Community League.

*The City has waived the weight fees but not the recycling fees.

Item	Enviro Fee

Washer/Dryer /Stove/Dishwasher	\$49/each
Fridge (regardless of size)	\$69/each
Freezer (regardless of size)	\$100/each
Tires (on or off rim)	\$5/each
Automotive Batteries	\$4/each
Mattress (regardless of size)	\$50/each

When the bins are full, no further items will be accepted regardless of day or time. If, on the other hand, it appears on the second day that there is additional room in the bins, a message will be sent out via *Rossdale Connect* alerting residents, and they will be allowed a second disposal. Again, this will be on a first-come, first served basis.

Your Rossdale Executive was successful in obtaining a \$600 grant from the City of Edmonton to help defray the cost of this event.
